# OTWAY EXPLORER

SUNDAY 10TH MARCH 2019

Departing from Southern Cross railway station – explore the Otway Ranges aboard Steamrail's Vintage Train, hauled by a diesel-electric locomotive (during the warmer weather steam locomotives are not able to be used). Sit back in comfortable air conditioned 1940s vintage compartment carriages. Relax over coffee and refreshments as the train roars across the flat volcanic plains and through historic towns to Colac and Camperdown. Enjoy wines and beers from the Otway region, travel into the Otway Ranges and walk in the tree tops at the Otway Fly, or explore Colac or Camperdown townships. After an enjoyable day out, relax with a light snack and refreshments from the kiosk.

## WINE AND BEER EXPERIENCE

- Talk to the brewer and sample some of the 18 varieties of hand crafted beers and ciders over a 2 course lunch at the Otway Estate brewery.
- Sample the wines of the region and relax to live music at the Gosling Creek Winery.
- Rejoin the train at the beautiful Birregurra railway station with its orchard of plum trees.

## OTWAY TREE TOP WALK

- Travel through the Otway Ranges, catching glimpses of the former Beech Forest narrow gauge railway, to the Otway Fly.
- Optional light one course lunch at the Otway Fly cafe.
- Walk amongst the tree tops, 30 metres above the ground, at the Otway Tree Top Walk.
- Explore the rain forest on the interactive trail – perfect for budding young rangers!
